- 383B. **TWO SCARIFICATORS.** Nineteenth century, brass. Octagonal with twelve blades engraved "Milliken's "London", 1 3/8"h. 1 7/8"w. 1 3/4"d. And unmarked with sixteen blades in period pasteboard box. 1 3/8"h. 1 3/4"w. 1 3/8"d. \$400-\$800
